Ash Wednesday is a day of Fast and Abstinence, no meat is to be eaten and meals should be small. A strict Fast would be bread and water only.</p>	<p>If you are on medications, you probably should not do a strict Fast. Fridays of Lent are days of Abstinence. No meat is to be eaten unless it is necessary due to medical reasons.</p>	<p>Most parishes have the Stations of the Cross on Wednesdays or Fridays during Lent. Make time to attend this special devotion every Friday during the Season of Lent.</p>
