IMPORTANT INFORMATION!	As you all know, our Mass times are changing and will take effect the first weekend of July (6/7): Saturday at 5:00 p.m. and Sunday at 8:00 a.m. (In association with this, Granger's Mass schedule will be Saturday at 7:00 p.m. and Sunday at 10:00 a.m.)
	Also, beginning with Monday, July 1, we will start our weekday Masses again and those will be announced in the Mass Intentions & Schedule box on the front page of the bulletin.

On Saturday, July 20, we will be offering an Ethics & Integrity in Ministry (EIM) Workshop in the PAC Building from 9:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. For those who aren't aware, this is a presentation, offered by the Diocese of Austin, to educate us on the terrible, but unfortunately too common, problem of child abuse by caregivers. The Diocese requires that everyone who works for, volunteers at, or is involved in any ministry in the parish is required to take this initial EIM workshop and then take a refresher course every three years after to stay aware of this topic. Therefore, if you are, for example, a VBS volunteer, CCE Catechist or volunteer, annual Bazaar worker/ volunteer, Mass minister (i.e. lector, Eucharistic minister, etc.), Pastoral/Finance Council member, etc --- and this short list only scratches the surface --- then you are required to be EIM Certified. If you do any of these or other things in the parish (or any other parish or parish school), and have NEVER taken an EIM Workshop, you should do so immediately – and here's a good opportunity. Also, if you are EIM Certified and need a refresher course, you are welcome to attend this workshop (it is not the shorter 1 ½ hr refresher, but it can serve as a refresher if it's convenient for you). ***An idea for those of you who took our '3 year refresher' in 2011 --- you will need to take it again by November 2014 --- though it is a year early, you can take this one and be good until November 2016. If you would like to attend this workshop, please RSVP to Jennifer (holytrinitycc@yahoo.com or 512-863-3020) by Sunday, July 7, so that we can have a head count for materials, etc. All questions about EIM can be directed to Jennifer as well.
