Dear friends in Christ,

Here we are on this Fifth Sunday of Easter. The Easter Season is quickly passing by. Many college students are preparing for final exams. It can be a nerve-wrecking time. We must always remind ourselves that Jesus gave us new life in His resurrection. We need to live in that new life, which means living in Him. May His resurrected life give you peace and comfort knowing that He is with you.

The month of May has begun and, during this month, we give honor to our Blessed Mother, Mary. Don't forget to pray the rosary daily, reflecting upon the mysteries for each day. In doing so, we grow closer to her Son, Jesus, and we grow stronger in our faith.

In today's Gospel, Jesus tells us that He is the vine and we are the branches. His Father will cut off from the vine those branches that do not bear fruit.
