Dear friends in Christ,

Praised be Jesus Christ! Thank you to everyone who attended my 20<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Mass and who prepared the meal and reception this past Wednesday. Your love and support are very much appreciated.

Many people will begin their summer vacations. Always remember to take a nice set of clothes along with you so that you will be properly dressed for Mass wherever you go. Please do not attend Mass in shorts if you are more than 6 years of age. Check ahead of time to locate a Catholic Church and find out the Mass times so that you will be on time for Mass. It is important that we do not neglect our worship of God and that we keep His Commandment to keep Holy the Sabbath Day. May everyone have a safe and enjoyable summer.

Today the Church celebrates the Feast of Corpus Christi, the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. Since the time of the Apostles, the Church has believed and taught that Jesus is present, body and blood, soul and divinity, in the Holy Communion that we receive at Mass. The bread and wine become the Body and Blood of Jesus during the consecration in the Eucharistic Prayer. The appearance remains the same, but the substance changes. This is not a symbolic presence --- it is the REAL PRESENCE of Jesus. That is why we take such care of the Blessed Sacrament, the Eucharist, and offer, to the Real Presence of Jesus, our Adoration and Praise. That is why we have our annual Corpus Christi Procession, to give a more public sign of our belief in this Real Presence. The early Church Fathers wrote about this presence, as did St. Paul in his letter to the Corinthians (1 Cor. 10:16–17, 11:23–29). May we all be careful of how we speak about the Holy Communion that we receive at Mass. We should speak of it as the Body of Christ and the Blood of Christ, not as bread and wine. We pray that one day all Christians will once again believe what the Apostles and the early Church believed about Jesus' Real Presence in Holy Communion.

As you can see, work is progressing in the restoration of our statues. While the artists are here, we decided to restore the statues for our nativity scene and a statue of the Risen Jesus. This work will cost an additional \$4,750.00. Donations to pay for this additional work would be greatly appreciated. Just call the parish office and let us know how much you would like to donate, or put your donation in an envelope and mark it "Statue Restoration" and drop it in the collection basket. Thank you for your generosity to your parish.
