### **Dear friends in Christ,**

May the peace and love of our Lord Jesus Christ be with each of you.

**On Saturday, July 18, we are having an Ethics and Integrity in Ministry workshop here at Holy Trinity.** If you are involved in any ministry in our parish, then you need to attend this workshop if you have not already done so. Today's Gospel reminds us of how we are to depend and trust in God for all of our needs when we are serving Him and His people. We oftentimes want to do everything on our own. We must have hearts and minds that are open to His Will and to His Way. Let us pray that we can put our faith and trust in our Lord in the way in which He will work out His plan in our lives of faith. In our world today, it seems that nobody thinks they have anything from which they need to repent. They do not have a concept of sin. When this happens, everything, no matter how sinful and wrong it may be, becomes acceptable. We see this in regards to abortion, contraception, sterilization, gay marriage, sodomistic activity, fornication, living together before marriage, drug use, lying, cheating, stealing and much more. We need to preach the need for repentance and the love and mercy that God wants to give to all people who do repent.
