May we continue to reflect upon Fr. Ken's talks and also continue to allow the Holy Spirit to speak to our hearts so that we can take what we heard and learned and live it each day.

This weekend we celebrate the Feast of All Saints. We remember those who have died and are with God in Heaven. In today's Gospel we read the Beatitudes, Jesus' instruction on happiness and saintliness. If we live the Beatitudes, we will definitely join the saints in heaven. How do you strive to live the Beatitudes in your personal life? Live them, and as we read in today's Gospel, "Rejoice and be glad, for your reward will be great in heaven."

We will also celebrate All Souls' Day on Monday as we pray for all those who have died and are on their way to Heaven. We pray that they may quickly pass through the purifying process in Purgatory and soon join the saints in Heaven. During the month of November, we will be praying for these souls in a special way. We do this because of what we read in Sacred Scripture in passages that pertain to the Church's teaching on Purgatory: Praying for and making an offering for the dead - 2 Maccabees 12:43-46; The need to make up for transgressions - Mt 5:25-26, Lk 12:58-59; nothing profane can enter heaven – Rev. 21:27; cleansing fire – 1 Cor 3:12-15; David, though forgiven, still punished for his sin – 2 Sam12:13-14. Jesus paid the price for our sins in general, but we still must make up for the individual sins that we do. Let us pray that we can truly be one of those Holy Ones of God. Please try to attend one of the Masses on Monday (noon or 6:00 p.m.).
