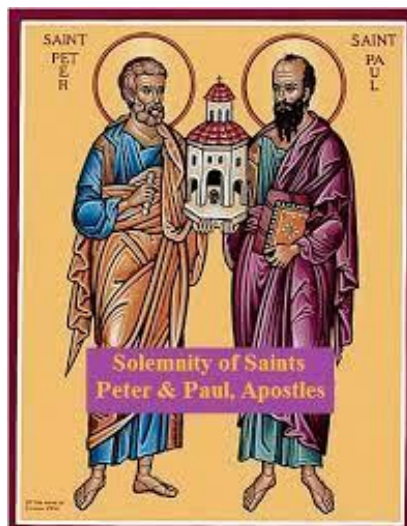

This weekend we welcome Fr. Don Loftin. He is a retired priest of the Diocese of Austin. Let us listen attentively to his inspiring message.

Today is the Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time. In today's Gospel Jesus tells us that the Kingdom of God is more important than anything else in our life. He says that those who do not put God and His Kingdom as the main priority in their life is not "fit for the kingdom of God." Is living your faith and passing it on to your children and grandchildren the most important thing in your life? Many people have a desire for living a good and holy life, but, they keep allowing themselves to be drawn back to a lifestyle that is unhealthy and not fit for a person who lives in God's Kingdom. Jesus says we have to stop looking back to what was and, instead, look forward to what is to come. He says in Luke's Gospel, "No one who sets a hand to the plow and looks to what was left behind is fit for the kingdom of God." If you keep looking back and do not watch where God is leading you you will soon stray off the path and end up in the ditch of life, a ditch that you might just get stuck in and never be able to get out. Keep your hand to the plow and do not grow tired or weary in living your faith. For those who persevere there is eternal life, eternal joy. Live in the Kingdom of God and live in His Love.

Myšlenky: My lidé máme báječnou schopnost převrátit ledasco vzhůru nohama, nepřijímat to, co je nám nabízeno a naopak chtít to, co nám není dáváno. Znovu a znovu se v pohledu na křesťanství objevuje staré nedorozumění: je chápáno nebo považováno jako cesta pro ty, kdo se chtějí všemu nepřijemnému v životě vyhnout, je považováno za lacinou cestu útěchy nebo iluze, na které se člověk snaží vyhnout jakémukoliv trápení. Toto nedorozumění není jen u lidí venku, jen u těch, kdo víru nežijí. Vyskytuje se i u křesťanů, kteří hledají nebo se domnívají mít různé recepty na zaručeně úspěšné vyřešení a odstranění všech možných těžkostí. Že bývají zklamáni, to je druhá věc. Chceme-li chápat správně, pak je třeba odložit vlastní přání a s otevřeným srdcem se zadívat do evangelia.

Když dnes čteme, že se Ježíš pevně rozhodl jít do Jeruzaléma, pak je třeba pod tím vidět, že se pevně rozhodl jít ke své smrti nebo jinak: k vrcholnému utkání se zlem, které se mělo (jako už u řady proroků) v Jeruzalémě naplnit. Toto rozhodnutí ovlivňuje jeho další cestu. Ale není to rozhodnutí, které vede k rezignaci: hned sem klade evangelista slova o následování: najdou se ti, kteří chtějí za Ježíšem, jsou jiní, které Ježíš sám vyzývá. Pro jedny i pro druhé však neexistuje cesta iluzí, ale cesta, která vede za Ježíšem. Je to cesta, na které nemá místo odplata, ale touha zachránit lidi. Je to cesta nejistoty a nezajištěnosti, větší nezajištěnosti, než jakou prožívají divoká zvířata. Ale je to cesta, na kterou se musí vykročit hned, protože je to cesta zvěstování Božího království. Kvůli tomu je třeba vše odložit, rodinné svazky, slušnost, zvyky, denní práce - věci samy o sobě dobré a samozřejmě - musí ustoupit z cesty.

Je samozřejmé, že evangelista neuvádí slova o následování jen jako historickou vzpomínku. Jsou to slova, která má slyšet každý, kdo čte evangelium. A staví křesťanství do světla, které mnohý nezná a jiní nechtějí znát. Cesta za Ježíšem je cestou, na které není člověk kříže ušetřen. Je to naopak cesta nezajištěnosti, cesta utkávání se zlem, na niž se člověk může vydat, protože právě jako křesťan může kříž přijmout. Nemusí se mu ani zbaběle ani nečestně vyhýbat. Nemusí se děsit jeho úplné nesmyslnosti: protože každé nesení kříže může být cestou, kterou se jde za Ježíšem, tedy cestou, která má smysl a která má své vyústění v Bohu. Nejde ovšem o cestu poraženectví nebo zvráceného zalíbení v utrpení. Ježíš nešel do Jeruzaléma proto, že by toužil po utrpení jako takovém. Jeho cesta byla vedena věrností k Otci a touhou lidi ne zahubit, ale zachránit. Tedy vůle obětovat, snaha prospět lidem ve skutečných hodnotách, ochota dávat ze svého, ze sebe - to jsou všechno motivy, které by měly vést křesťana životem. A tuto cestu může člověk jít jako křesťan s plnou odvahou i s tou nejkrajnější obětavostí, na které ztrácí i sám sebe. Ne ve jménu jakési nejasné budoucnosti nebo ve jménu jakéhosi mlhavého ideálu, ale ve jménu konkrétního vztahu lásky k Bohu a k lidem. Když by bylo možné nějak zařídit, aby toto podstatné z evangelia vzali na vědomí a pochopili všichni ti, co do kostelů chodí, co se za křesťany považují, ne jeden z nich by asi odešel se slovy, tohle přece nehledal. Ale byli by naopak jiní, kteří by přišli ... (Pastorace.cz)
