The **Finance Council** will meet on Thursday, July 21, at 7:00 p.m. in the RE Bldg.

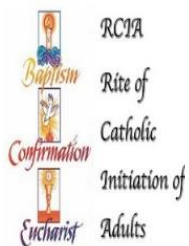
We will have our monthly **Building Fund Collection** next weekend (July 23/24). Thank you in advance for your generosity.

To serve as a Mass Minister, Catechist or CCE Volunteer, on a parish council, etc, you must be certified in the diocesan Ethics & Integrity in Ministry (EIM) course, but please don't let this stop you from volunteering, as it is an easy process that only takes 2 hours of your time every three years. EIM Policies require all clergy, religious, seminarians, employees and adult volunteers serving in any EIM compliance-required ministry to submit an EIM Application for Ministry (www.austindiocese.org/application) (one-time only) and attend an in-person EIM Workshop (www.austindiocese.org/initial-eim-training) within 60 days, and update/renew compliance at least once every three years. **Online EIM Training (www.austindiocese.org/onlineeimtraining)** is available for existing applicants who have previously attended a workshop and are due to update/renew their EIM compliance. RCIA Classes to Begin September 6, 2022 - RCIA is the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults -- a process for welcoming new members into the Roman Catholic Church. It is a community journey that leads to a transformation of mind and spirit. The RCIA is mainly for non-Catholics who want to become Catholic, but adult Catholics who have not received all of the Sacraments (Communion, Confession, Confirmation) may also come into full communion with the Church through the RCIA process. Dear friends in Christ,

Peace be with you. The summer holidays will soon be gone. What have you been doing during these summer months? Have you taken a vacation? Have you taken some extra time to rest? Hopefully you have been able to escape from the heat. Whatever it is you have been doing I hope that you have taken time to pray and to grow in your relationship with the Most Holy Trinity. In doing so, your summer months will have been very beneficial and profitable, and you will be prepared to return to school or work after finding refreshment in our Lord.

In today's Gospel we hear about Martha and Mary, and in today's first reading we hear about Abraham. We often think that these people had great faith from the beginning. But they, like us, had to grow in faith and trust in God. We see this as Abraham first responds to his visitors in faith and then doubts how God will make their message of Sarah having a child become a reality. He tries to make things happen his own way and he gets into trouble. Only when he allows God to work things out and Abraham actually follows God's will, does his faith really begin to grow to the level that God is asking it to be. The same is true with Martha and Mary. However, it seems that the Mary in today's Gospel learned this before her sister, Martha. Martha needed a little more convincing of God's goodness to her and that God wants her to know of His love for her and that this love is not dependent on her being busy and always doing something. We often think that people are not of value unless they are doing something. We too need to take the time just to relax and allow God to love us in His own way. May our faith grow so that we will be like Abraham, Martha, and Mary, when they allowed God to be a loving presence in their life.

K úvaze: Nedávno jsem byl na návštěvě u velmi hodných lidí. Přijemných. Pozorných. Štědrých. Rozkrájeli by se. A doslova neustále krájeli a porcovali maso, knedlíky, zákusky, pečivo. „Jezte, vy nic jíte!“ A rád bych prohodil pár slov, ale nebylo to možné: neustále pendlovali mezi kuchyní a jídelnou, případně se hovor točil kolem jídla. Odcházel jsem se smíšenými pocity. A přitom.... ti hostitelé to mysleli upřímně a dobře. Chybělo jedno: osobní setkání.

A Marta? Podobný případ. A přitom... stačilo málo: sednout si, poslouchat. Tak málo. A tak mnoho by tato „pečlivka ustaraná“ potřebovala Ježíšova slova, která jsou duch a život.

Možná sotva věříme tomu, že je možné „propást“ tak jedinečnou šanci: co je jednoduššího než zaujmout Mariin postoj? Ale, ruku na srdce, mnohdy je pohodlnější zmateně běhat, zařizovat – pohodlnější než se zastavit a naslouchat. Kolikrát nasloucháš ty Pánu? Máš vůbec odvahu se ho ptát, jestli se pustit do nějaké dobročinné akce nebo do lákové pastorační činnosti?

A ještě jeden podnět: Co bys dělal, kdyby Ježíš přišel k tobě na návštěvu? Anebo lépe – co děláš, když Ježíš k tobě přichází na návštěvu? Moc těžká otázka! Asi namítáš: „A kdy vůbec Ježíš přišel ke mně?“ Přišel, přichází... přinejmenším tehdy, když ho přijímáš v eucharistii. Přinejmenším. (Pastorace.cz)
