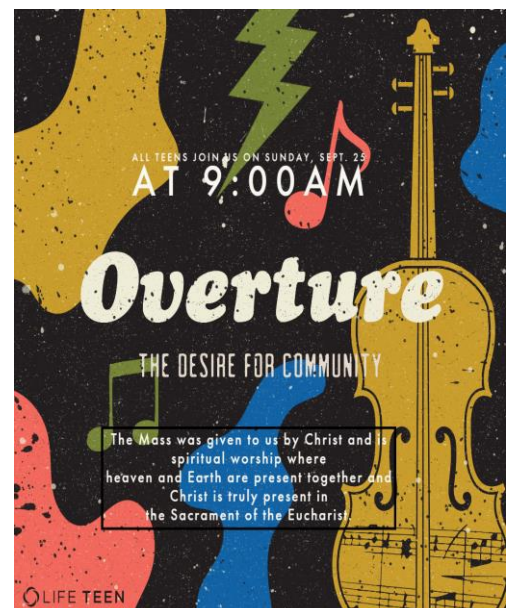
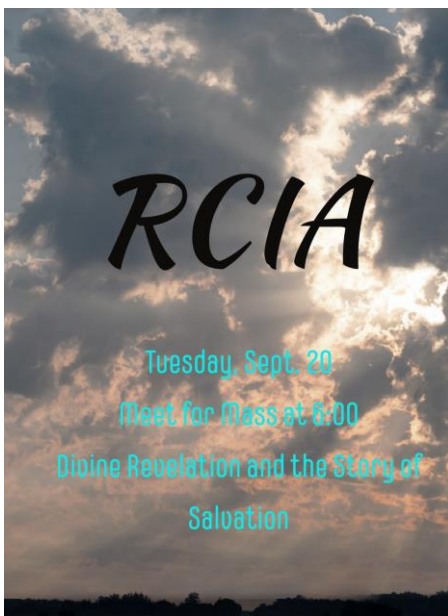

Holy Trinity Catholic Church hosts in Partnership with Elite Medical Imaging, their annual Preventive Ultrasound Health Screening on **Saturday, October 1, 2022**. Screenings will be done in the CCE Room by appointment only. Eight preventive screenings will be offered: carotid artery, abdominal aorta, thyroid, liver, spleen, gallbladder and both kidneys. These screenings are not typically done at physician's visits or at annual check-ups, nor will insurance companies pay for them, unless you are symptomatic. Screenings will be offered to you for \$60 each or the full preventive package, (all 8 areas) for just \$170.00! Flex spending and Health Savings accounts may be used to pay for these screenings the day of service, as well as cash and all major credit/debit cards. Our radiologist team recommends these screenings be considered on an annual basis as a preventive measure. Oftentimes results can change from one year to the next based on age, stress factors, family history and lifestyle. A representative from EMI will be at Holy Trinity **September 24th and 25th** to offer pre-registration and answer any questions you may have. Dear friends in Christ,

Peace be with you. We welcome all visitors who have come to enjoy a day of fun and fellowship as we celebrate our annual Parish Bazaar. I hope everyone enjoys the meal and that y'all have a wonderful day. Thank you for coming and may God's blessings be upon you all.

Our Religious Education Program began two weeks ago. I thank all of our parents for bringing their children to learn about the Bible, Jesus Christ, and His Church. Parents are always invited and encouraged to attend the Mass at 6:30 p.m. on Wednesday. For those who go to Youth Ministry on Sundays, all parents are asked to join their children for the Sunday Mass at 10:30 am. Your presence at Mass is a great sign of support to your children. Please come and join us as we celebrate this awesome gift that our Lord has given to us.

This week, Wednesday, we celebrate the **Feast of St. Matthew**, apostle and evangelist. Matthew is the writer of the first of the four gospels in the Bible. He wrote his gospel in Aramaic which was the main language spoken by the people in his area. His gospel was written between the years of 42 and 85 AD. He wrote his gospel mainly for the largely Jewish-Christian audience as most of the Christians in his community had converted from Judaism. His gospel seeks to portray Christianity as consistent with the Jewish tradition and a continuation of it. Matthew preached in Judea and in Ethiopia where he was martyred. He is symbolized by the winged human being as mentioned in the first chapter of Ezekiel and as seen on one of our stained glass windows. Matthew is the patron saint of accountants, bankers, bookkeepers, customs officers, security guards, stock brokers and tax collectors. We are thankful to St. Matthew for giving us an account of the life of Jesus and for helping to spread the message of the Jesus and in helping to form the early Church in far off lands. Let us honor him by attending Mass on his feast day.

In today's gospel we read about a steward who was in charge of collecting what the debtors owed his master. This steward was also in charge of his master's property. The steward has squandered some of the property and when his master found out about it his master decided to terminate his employment. The steward acts wisely by making he and his master look good by lowering the amount that the debtors owed his master. He was actually just probably lowering the bills by the amount of commission that he himself would have received. The master commends the steward for being acting in a prudent way in making sure he would be liked and probably hired by one of the debtors. Jesus is telling us that we should be equally wise in planning for our future, not in an earthly sense, but in a spiritual sense, preparing ourselves for eternal life. How well are you preparing for eternal life? Is what you are doing now leading you to heaven or to hell? Are you good stewards of your time by giving part of your time to God each day? Do you spend some time praying every day? Do you go to Mass every weekend? Do you go to confession regularly, at least four times a year? Do you do acts of charity for your Church and for others? Do you read the Bible daily? Being good stewards means being able to say "yes" to these questions. If your answer is no to one of these questions, then you are not being the steward God wants you to be. May we all be the best of stewards in our life with God so that we will be with Him now and for all eternity.

K úvaze: A tak se zdá, že tuneláři se sice nemohou odvolávat na nějaké státní zákony (legitimně interpretované), ale přece jen se mohou opírat o... Zákon nový, tedy o Bibli. Vždyť Bible vychvaluje toho nepoctivého služebníka, ne? Ten služebník se vlastně ukázal jako předchůdce novodobých tunelářů: nebyl však potrestán, ale naopak oceněn.

Při bližším a „poctivém“ pohledu však objevíme, že takový výklad by byl proti celkovému učení Bible a, koneckonců, proti všeobecně uznávaným zásadám mravního jednání. Ježíš nevyzdvihl onoho služebníka pro jeho nepoctivost, ale spíš pro jeho prozíravost. V kritické situaci se nenechal přemoci poraženectvím a duchem skleslosti, ale popřemýšlel, jak dál. Uvedl do pohybu své mozkové závity a promyslel dokonalý plán. Zřejmě i předtím promyšleně zneužíval cizí majetek, jenže teď překonal sebe sama a byl za to dokonce pochválen svým pánem. Tak jako předtím se dokázal prosadit, tak i v nové „kritické“ situaci. Jeho promyšlené, chytré a důmyslné jednání je právě tou vlastností, která tolik „fascinovala“ pána: tato důmyslnost byla oceněna, ne nepoctivost či krádež.

A tato promyšlenost je nám kladena jako „vzor“. Pokud nás onen služebník tolik neinspiruje k prozíravému a promyšlenému chování, tak si vezměme jiné příklady, ze současného světa. Stačí otevřít noviny a... narazíme na mnoho „správců“ majetku, kteří se zřejmě nechali inspirovat naším prozíravým správcem. Jednoznačné odsouzení takové nepoctivosti (a možná i rozhořčení) nám nemusí zavírat oči, abychom dokázali vidět, čím se můžeme nechat od nich inspirovat: promyšleností, chytrostí, prozíravostí. A stejně jako „ten náš služebník“, i tito dokážou využívat majetku k navázání „vhodných“ a prospěšných přátelství. Taková „zlodějí“ (ať už větší či menší) to mají většinou „promakané“ (pokud jsou dobrými zloději). Pokud by Ježíš žil v České republice v současné době, tak by možná postavil „tuneláře“ do role onoho správce. A opět – Ježíš by nevyzdvihl nepoctivost, ale spíš promyšlené a „promakané“ jednání.

A z takových lidí si můžeme vzít příklad a jednat stejně tak prozíravě, promyšleně. Co to konkrétně znamená? Dnešní doba nás učí, že majetek „se má investovat“ (a to je koneckonců i zásadou toho služebníka). Majetek se má správně investovat, důmyslným způsobem: proto tolik poradenských kancelářů. A my můžeme vsadit na jinou kancelář, možná ne tak výdělečnou jako ty „špičkové“, ale přesto garantující jistou budoucnost. Tato kancelář asi nenabízí tak atraktivní a výnosné zisky, ale přesto jsou to zisky, které moli nerozežerou a zloději neukradnou... a nevytunelují. (Pastorace.cz)
