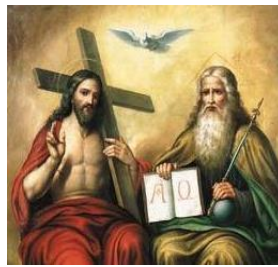

Praised be Jesus Christ! Please plan on attending our Parish Mission this week. Make this an important part of your preparation for celebrating the Birth of Jesus at Christmas. Please pray for the success of our Parish Mission by praying the prayer that may be found on the back this bulletin. Let us encourage one another and your families to attend this mission. On Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday of the Parish Mission a free meal will be served. On Thursday there will be a reception after the Mass and mission talk so that all of you may be able to meet and speak with Fr. John. See that back of the bulletin for the meal and mission times. May we all have a very spiritually renewing week.

He also says there will be wars, earthquakes, famines, plagues and signs in the sky. Those who try to be faithful to Jesus and His Church are already being persecuted. In the years ahead this persecution will only increase. The question for each and everyone of us is, "Will you still be faithful?" or will you give in and accept the pagan ways of the world. Our Blessed Mother, Mary, has warned us in the various times she has appeared in the last 100 years that this persecution would occur and now it has begun. Will you be faithful when it directly affects you? Will you say, "Long live Jesus Christ the King" or will you abandon Him as so many Christians have done? They have given in to the ways of world when it comes to abortion, gay marriage, contraception, lying, cheating, not going to Mass, and becoming selfish and self-centered. Posledním pánem dějin není Zlo (srov. první čtení), ale Bůh. Je to čas, kdy se blíží konečné vítězství Boha, dobra, spravedlnosti. Když zakoušíme hrůzy obtížné doby, platí stejná povzbuzení.
