**He is Risen! He is Truly Risen!** Today, in a very special way, we celebrate the Resurrection of the Lord. As we celebrate this day we must always remember that in order for Jesus to rise from the dead He first had to endure terrible torture and pain. He first had to carry the cross, be nailed to it, and then die upon it. This is what we have celebrated in this Sacred Paschal Triduum, from Holy Thursday through Easter Sunday. In reality, this is what we remember and celebrate every time we celebrate the Mass. The event of our redemption and salvation is continued through the celebration of the Mass every day of the year. That is why the Mass has redemptive value for those who have died and that is why we celebrate Mass for the repose of their soul. 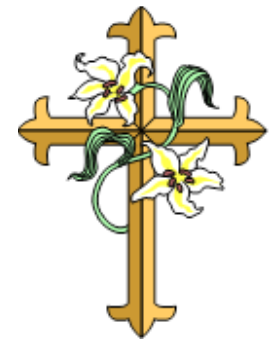
