

### Dear friends in Christ.

Praised be Jesus Christ! I hope all of you have had a wonderful week. The hot weather continues. Usually during summer we are tempted to dress rather lightly or skimpy for Mass. We need to remember that as we come to Mass we come to worship God and to receive His Son, Jesus, in Holy Communion. We should dress in a way that shows respect for God. After all, isn't God, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, the love of your life? We need to show God how much we truly love Him. We do this by the way we dress for Mass and by coming to Mass on time and waiting to leave until after the prayer after the closing hymn. The general rule that I believe is appropriate is that anyone over 6 years of age should not wear shorts to Mass. Also, girls and ladies should wear blouses or dresses that are appropriate for Mass, nothing strapless or no spaghetti straps. Ask yourself if you stand in honor in His presence? Is God proud of you by how you come before Him? Does the way you dress for Mass give praise to God?

Next Sunday, July 16, begins **Vacation Bible School**. Please pray for all the children who will be attending. May they experience the love of God and grow in understanding of their faith.

In today's Gospel Jesus says: "Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am meek and humble of heart; and you will find rest for yourselves. For my yoke is easy, and my burden light." What Jesus says is so true. However, most people do not take on the yoke of Jesus, one that is tailor made, fits perfectly and does not cause pain. Instead we make our own yokes, thinking we know better than Jesus. Then, after a while, we realize our yoke is too heavy, burdensome, and causing us much pain. And, for some reason we are not able to get rid of the yoke we have made for ourselves. We seem to cling to it, thinking we will work it out ourselves. Go to confession, get rid of that burdensome yoke, make a dramatic change in your life and put on the yoke of Jesus. It may be a painful experience to do this, but you will be glad you did.

This Friday, July 14, a friend of mine is arriving from the Czech Republic. His name is Vít Mužný. He will stay until August 22. Vít came to Texas in August of 2017 with his brother, Martin, and his cousin Lukáš, and Fr. Michal Jadavan. They traveled the western USA and visited many national parks. Fr. Michal died of cancer in February of 2018. Vít is in college and is coming here to work on his English. Let us show him a good Texas welcome.

**K** úvaze: Je to paradoxní. Kristus říká "pojďte ke mně a přijměte mé slovo, a tak najdete odpočinek", a my často nechceme přicházet ke Kristu právě proto, že jsme unavení a nemáme sílu brát na sebe další závazky, "obtížit se jeho slovy". Máme totiž za to, že Kristovo slovo je především úkolem. A jsme-li už dost vyčerpaní ze svých povinností, jak se zmobilizovat a naslouchat dalším nárokům? Lepší se "vyhnout" evangeliu, otevřít spíš noviny či nějakou odpočinkovou knihu ... Bohužel za tímto postojem se někdy ukrývá představa, že evangelium je dalším břemenem (a těch máme přece jen dost!), ne oázou v palčivém horku všedního dne. Abychom dostali "novou chut" na živou vodu evangelia, je třeba se zaposlechnout do dnešního úryvku. Tam Kristus boří naše falešné představy o učení evangelia: je to učení přinášející oddechnutí, osvěžení. Dalo by se říci, že jeho učení je číší chladné vody ve vyprahlé poušti našeho života. Objevím-li pravou Kristovu tvář, odkryji také skutečnou povahu jeho slova. Je-li Kristus zákoníkem, pak jeho slovo bude také jen zákonem. A bude-li Kristus mým průvodcem, pak jeho slovo bude ukazatelem cesty. A pokud jsem objevil, že bez Krista jen živořím, pak ... bez jeho slova nebudu schopen žít!
