We will have a **Pastoral and Finance Council Meeting** on Tuesday, July 9, in the RE Bldg, immediately following the 6:00 p.m. Mass. All parishioners are invited and encouraged to attend.

On Saturday, July 20, we will be offering an Ethics & Integrity in Ministry (EIM) Workshop in the PAC Building from 9:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. For those who aren't aware, this is a presentation, offered by the Diocese of Austin, to educate us on the too common problem of child abuse by caregivers. The Diocese requires that everyone who works for, volunteers at, or is involved in any ministry in a parish/school is required to take this initial EIM workshop and then a refresher course every three years after to stay aware of this topic. **If you are, for example, a VBS volunteer, CCE Catechist or volunteer, fundraiser/Bazaar worker/volunteer, Mass minister (i.e. lector, Eucharistic minister, etc.), Pastoral/Finance Council member, etc --- and this list only scratches the surface --- then you are required to be EIM Certified. If you do any of this/or other in a parish/parish school), and have NEVER taken an EIM Workshop, you should do so immediately.** Also, if you are EIM Certified and need a refresher course, you may attend this workshop as a refresher. *****An idea for those of you who took our '3 year refresher' in 2011 --- you will need to take it again by November 2014 --- though it is a year early, you can take this one and be good until November 2016. If you would like to attend this workshop, please RSVP to Jennifer (holyltrinitycc@yahoo.com or 512-863-3020) by Sunday, July 7, so that we can have a head count for materials, etc.**

My hometown is in Abbott, Texas which is about 25 miles North of Waco. My parents are Edwin and Doris Nesrsta and I have one sister, Evelyn, and two brothers, Larry and Edward. I am the youngest in the family. My home parish is Immaculate Heart of Mary in Abbott, which I attended during my years at home. My father died in 2006. Mother still living in Abbott.

Graduated as salutatorian from Abbott High School in 1978. Attended Hill Junior College 1978 to 1980 with an Associate of Arts Degree in Business. Employment: Nickerson Farms Restaurant 1974 to 1981. Lake Air National Bank Waco (InterFirst Bank) 1981 to 1987.

Entered Seminary in 1987. Attended Holy Trinity Seminary in Dallas from 1987 to 1990 receiving a Bachelor's Degree in Philosophy at the University of Dallas. Attended St. Mary's Seminary in Houston from 1990 to 1995 receiving a Masters of Divinity Degree through the University of St. Thomas.

Ordained a Priest on June 3, 1995. Served as Associate Pastor at St. Mary's in Temple, Texas from 1995 to 1996 and then as Pastor from 1996 to October 31, 2003; Pastor of St. Ann in Somerville, Texas and Blessed Virgin Mary in Washington, Texas, March 2004 to January 2007; Pastor of St. John in Fayetteville, St. Mary in Ellinger/Hostyn Hill, and St. Martin in Warrenton, January 2007 to June 2013.
