Dear friends in Christ,

May the peace, love, hope, joy and forgiveness of God be with each of you. Thank you to everyone who helped out with our Sts. Cyril and Methodius celebration last Sunday. A good time was had by all.

How is your Lenten observance going? Did you attend Stations of the Cross this past Wednesday? Make the most of this season and grow in your life of faith by spending more time in prayer, fasting and almsgiving. Come to the Stations of the Cross every Wednesday and walk with Jesus on His journey to Calvary. Take a day each week to fast from food or from something else that would help you to be a better Christian. For almsgiving we will once again participate in the Ashes to Easter collection for the Diocese of Austin. This collection helps specific missionary work of our diocese. Check the bulletin to watch for this upcoming collection. Put some effort into this season and you will be blessed in many ways.

In today's Gospel we hear about the transfiguration of Jesus on the mountain. With Him are Peter, James and John. They experience Jesus in His heavenly state of being. Moses and Elijah appear on the mountain with Jesus -- Moses representing the Law and giving his approval to Jesus by his presence there and Elijah, representing the prophets and thus giving his approval to Jesus by his presence. What a wonderful experience this must have been for the three apostles. To hear the voice of God say "This is my beloved Son. Listen to Him." Wow! Every time we gather for Mass we are on the mountain with Jesus. We listen to His words. We have a very personal encounter with Him as His Body and Blood become present to us in the Eucharist and then we receive Jesus in Holy Communion. It is a very intimate and personal moment. Do we realize what is happening? Or, are we rather confused like the apostles were on the mountain not knowing what to say? All of us are called to be with Jesus and to experience His majesty and His love. Do we? Is there something keeping us from experiencing what He wants us to experience during the celebration of Holy Mass? It is really a test of faith. In today's first reading from Genesis we hear about Abraham and how his faith was tested as God asked him to take his only son, Isaac, up to the mountain to offer him as a holocaust, as a sacrifice. Abraham experienced the glory of God because he was willing to do what was asked of him. He let go of his pride and his own wants and desires. We must do the same if we are to experience the glory of God and His love every time we go to Mass and when we go to pray. May God's grace be with you so that you have such an experience.

Please take time to attend the **Stations of the Cross** each Wednesday evening. This is a very powerful devotion which will foster an increase in your love for what Jesus has done for you.

May all of you have a blessed Lenten week.

Jak jen mohou přijmout a opřít se vírou o to, že je skutečně Boží Syn, který přináší spásu každému člověku? Zůstanou věrnými i v okamžiku jeho smrti na kříži? Pán jim nabízí zážitek, dech beroucí situaci, kdy sám stojí uprostřed (!) největších postav Starého zákona a dějin Izraele. A dokonce zaslechnou znovu hlas Boha Otce. Naše víra má své kroky a etapy. Patří k ní zážitky. Ale také situace v Getsemanech, u kříže nebo etapy pouště. Ale cílem všech těchto momentů je živý vztah s Bohem.

Segundo Domingo de Cuaresma: Este domingo somos desafiados por esta pregunta: ¿Estamos dispuestos a realizar todo el viaje a través de la tentación, el sufrimiento, la muerte y la resurrección como participantes con Cristo o nos convertiremos en observadores solamente? Ser un discípulo de Jesús involucra riesgo. Puede significar que tenemos que dejar el confort, la seguridad del "hogar" para ir a un lugar nuevo que Dios escoja. Las lecturas de este domingo nos piden darnos cuenta de que el viaje Cristiano tiene riesgos, sufrimiento y muerte, pero termina con la gloria para aquellos que caminan con Cristo ¿Está usted dispuesto a correr ese riesgo?
