Dear Parishioners.

He is Risen! He is Truly Risen! A joyful Resurrection Day to all of you! Jesus is risen from the dead. In today's Gospel we read about the resurrection as found in the Gospel of John. Mary of Magdala goes to the tomb of Jesus early in the morning and sees that the stone has been removed. She quickly runs to the apostles and tells Peter and John about what she has discovered. Peter and John run to the tomb. John arrives first, since he is younger than Peter and he waits for Peter to arrive and then Peter enters the tomb first and then John follows. He recognizes the authority of Peter as the head of the Apostles. They saw and believed. Jesus gives us the same opportunity to believe and share in His resurrection. When we say we believe it means that we will do our best to live what we believe, living a life of faithfulness to Jesus and to His Church. 
