

Dear friends in Christ,

Praised be Jesus Christ! Today at the 10:30 am Sunday Mass we welcome our graduates. We pray God's blessings up them as they will soon graduate and begin a new chapter in their life. May they always be open to the Holy Spirit's guidance and truly seek the Spirit's direction in their life. May their future be filled with love, joy, peace and friendship and may they always be assured of God's loving presence with them in whatever they believe God is calling them to in life.

"Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of Thy faithful and enkindle in them the fire of Thy love." This weekend we celebrate the great feast of Pentecost. We remember the day that the Apostles, our Blessed Mother, Mary, and some other disciples were in the upper room behind locked doors praying, waiting, and wondering what they should do. The Holy Spirit came upon them as "tongues of fire" on their heads. This is what the bishop's hat, the mitre, represents. After receiving the Holy Spirit, they were all able to speak in different tongues (languages). Notice that people could understand what they were saying. They did not speak some kind of babbling that no one could understand. They also were filled with courage to go into the public and proclaim the message of Jesus. We have received that same Holy Spirit. Let us pray that we have the same courage and faith of the Apostles so that we will proclaim the truths of Jesus Christ and His Church without fear. Pentecost is also seen as the birthday of the Church. For two thousand years the Holy Spirit has continued to lead the Church in the fullness of Truth. That is why the Church has a vital role of being the voice of God to the world when it comes to be His authority in regards to Faith and Morals. May we always listen attentively to what the Church is saying and try to understand its teachings before we make comments about them. Jesus' promise is fulfilled in the Catholic Church and He is with it always until the end of time which will take place when He returns in all His glory.

You and I need to claim Jesus as our Lord - not just with our lips, but with our lives. Today's feast of Pentecost reminds us that only by the Holy Spirit can you or I say, "Jesus is Lord." Like the early Christians, we can do nothing better than open our hearts to that greatest of all gifts. But yet, many hearts remain closed to allowing the Holy Spirit to work within them. Remember how St. Augustine prayed for the grace of conversion during his wild and sinful youth? "Give me your grace, Lord. But not yet!" Doesn't that sound like you and I at various times in our life? We celebrate Pentecost because we need to do what the apostles did - and do it now: accept and receive within us the Spirit who has been present to us from the moment of birth.

We need to accept the wonderful gifts our Father gives us through His Son by the power of the Holy Spirit within the Church. God has provided us with a feast for life. Let us not ignore it or turn away from it. Let us partake of this feast in its totality and live the life God wants for us. May God help us to pray "Come Holy Spirit" with hearts that are truly open!

Many people will very soon begin their summer vacations. Always remember to take a nice set of clothes along with you so that you will be properly dressed for Mass wherever you go. Please do not attend Mass in shorts if you are more than 6 years of age. Check ahead of time to locate the Catholic Church and find out the Mass times so that you will be on time for Mass. It is important that we do not neglect our worship of God and that we keep His Commandment to keep Holy the Sabbath Day.

As we continue to honor our Blessed Mother, Mary, during this month of May, don't forget to pray the rosary daily reflecting upon the mysteries for each day. In doing so we grow closer to her Son, Jesus, and we grow stronger in our faith.
