#### Dear friends in Christ.

Happy Feast Day! Today is the Feast Day of our Parish, Holy Trinity. It is a day to celebrate! "O most Holy Trinity, Undivided unity, Holy God, mighty God, God immortal be adored!" This is the refrain of one the hymns in honor of the Holy Trinity, God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit. One God, Three Divine Persons. A mystery of our faith. This mystery was revealed to us by Jesus as He said "Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit..." as we heard in today's Gospel according to Matthew. Jesus also spoke of Himself as the Son and how He and the Father are one. He also spoke of sending us the Holy Spirit, which we celebrated last Sunday on the feast of Pentecost. Our belief in the Trinity is central to our faith as Christians. It is one of the teachings that all Christians profess, even if they never mention the term in their services, and it is one of the teachings that must be professed by every denomination if they are going to call themselves Christian. We profess our belief in the Trinity every time we make the Sign of the Cross and any time a blessing is given by a priest or deacon. Also, we usually end our prayer by saying "Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit. As it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end. Amen." May the most holy Trinity bless us all.

Next weekend is the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, also known as Corpus Christi. **We will have a procession with the Blessed Sacrament after the 5:00 pm Mass on Saturday.** Let us join together to honor the Body and Blood of our Lord present in the Eucharist, the Blessed Sacrament, by participating in this procession. To God be all glory and honor, now and forever.

Please pray for all the priests of the Diocese of Austin as they attend a meeting Tuesday thru Thursday of this week in Horseshoe Bay, west of Austin. May the Holy Spirit guide them in their discussions.



**K ZAMYŠLENÍ:** Pojem Nejsvětější Trojice nastiňuje více míst Nového zákona, jako např. závěr dnešního evangelia. Zvláště v Janově evangeliu vidíme, že pojem Trojice odvozujeme z popisovaných vazeb mezi Otcem, Synem a Duchem. Z toho plyne, že základní vlastnost Boha je vztah. Bůh žije z nekonečně milujícího vztahu mezi Bohem Otcem a Bohem Synem, resp. jejich společného sdílení Ducha svatého. Bůh Otec nikdy nepřestal naprosto milovat Syna a také Syn nikdy nepřestal milovat Otce. Je třeba se vzdát pokřivených teorií, kde Ježíš smiřuje člověka s Otcem tím, že si na něm Bůh Otec vylije hněv za hříšné lidstvo. Opak je pravdou. Otec miluje Syna tak, že by pro něj udělal cokoli, a podobě i Syn. A právě Bůh Syn se pro lásku k Otci stává člověkem. A Bůh Otec s nesmírnou bolestí připustil, že milovaný Syn se vydal na cestu záchrany člověka za cenu sebeobětování. Tato bolest Otce je jeho oběť, dar člověku. Ale právě pro vzájemnou lásku Otce a Syna žádná smrt nemůže přerušit vztah proudící mezi osobami Trojice. A do tohoto místa žáru lásky je nyní pozván každý člověk, který přijal Krista.
