Dear friends in Christ,

May the peace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you. We welcome all of our guests this weekend who have come for our annual Pariah Bazaar. We hope you will have a wonderful meal and an enjoyable day with us. Thank you for coming to support Holy Trinity Parish.

In today's readings St. James tells us that faith without works is dead. If we say we have faith, then it must be seen by the works that we do, otherwise our faith is of no use and will not assist us in entering the Kingdom of Heaven. There is no such thing as a "faith alone" salvation. Sacred Scripture makes this very clear. Faith and works must go together if we are to truly be followers of Jesus. In the Gospel today St. Peter makes a profession of faith as he tells Jesus, "You are the Christ." Even as he makes this bold profession of faith his human nature tries to interfere with his faith as he does not want to see Jesus suffer and die. The same is true in today's day and time for us as we struggle with our human nature and many times think only as human beings do and not as God. May our faith sustain us in these struggles against what is true and what is according to the ways of God.

On Saturday, September 21, at the 7:30 am Mass, we will celebrate the **Feast of St. Matthew, Apostle and Evangelist**. In the "Chosen" series he is presented as a very interesting character. A very intelligent and questioning young man. He was a tax collector, also known as a publican. These people were not liked by the Jews. Catholicculture.org gives us the following information about Matthew: [One day, while seated at his table of books and money, Jesus looked at Matthew and said two words: "Follow me." This was all that was needed to make Matthew rise, leaving his pieces of silver to follow Christ. His original name, "Levi," in Hebrew signifies "Adhesion" while his new name in Christ, Matthew, means "Gift of God." The only other outstanding mention of Matthew in the Gospels is the dinner party for Christ and His companions to which he invited his fellow tax-collectors. The Jews were surprised to see Jesus with a publican, but Jesus explained that he had come "not to call the just, but sinners."] Come and celebrate his feast day with us at Mass. **May God's blessings be upon you all.**
