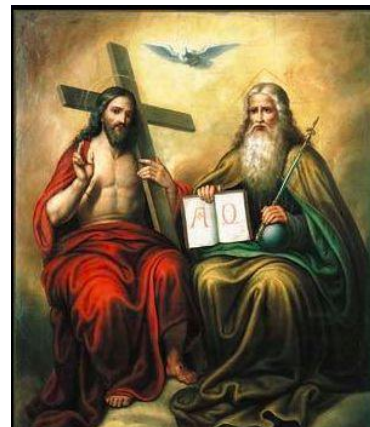

Mark your calendars to attend our annual **Czech Mass** in honor of Sts. Cyril and Methodius. The Mass will be on Sunday, February 16, at 5:00 pm.

In today's Gospel Jesus is in the synagogue in Nazareth and picks up the scroll and reads a passage from the book of the prophet Isaiah. Then, after reading the passage, Jesus tells those who are gathered there that the passage is fulfilled in their hearing it read by Him. They must have thought Jesus to be crazy or maybe even overly proud of Himself. They probably thought that Jesus thought more of Himself than he should have. What would you have been thinking if you had been there? I think we would have all been a little confused. Thanks be to God that Jesus has given us the Church so that we may know who He is and believe in Him. We are fortunate to know the truth and have it explained to us. May we hold fast to that truth and live our life in Jesus with conviction.

Next Sunday is the **Feast of the Presentation of the Lord**. It is the tradition of the Church that we bless candles on this day. If you would like to have your candles blessed bring them to the 7:30, 9:30 or 11:30 am Masses and place them on the table that will be in front of the St. Joseph Altar and I will bless them at the beginning of Mass.

**Monday, February 3, is the feast day of St. Blaise.** It is the day that we bless throats of those who wish to receive the blessing of St. Blaise. We will have two Masses on Monday, February 3, at 12:00 noon and 6:00 pm. Come to one of these Masses if you would like to have your throat blessed.
