Fr. Andy Cravalho was born in Hawaii and grew up in northern California for most of his life before graduating from Mother of Divine Grace homeschooling curriculum in 2001. He graduated from Franciscan University in Steubenville in 2005 with a B.A. in Journalism. After working as a sports journalist in California, Fr. Andy felt God’s call to the priesthood. He entered the Fathers of Mercy in 2006 and took first vows in August 2007. He then received his M.A. in Moral Theology from Holy Apostles Seminary in Cromwell, CT, and was ordained to the priesthood on June 2, 2012. After a year of serving four parishes in the Archdiocese of Louisville, KY, Fr. Andy was reassigned to the Fathers of Mercy missions.

**The Congregation of the Fathers of Mercy** was founded in 1808, originally under the title of “the Missionaries of France.” The community was founded for the purpose of re-evangelizing the French people after the Catholic Faith had been subjected to years of attacks and persecution during the French Revolution. It is now an exclusively American community, headquartered in South Union, KY. The primary apostolate of the Fathers of Mercy is to conduct parish missions and retreats in effort to re-evangelize and revitalize the faith of all who hear.
