#### Dear friends in Christ,

We have now returned to the season of Ordinary Time, in which we focus upon the not so ordinary life and ministry of Jesus. In today's Gospel, Jesus is called the "Lamb of God" by John the Baptizer. I am sure this term would have caught the ears of all those around him and would have sparked their curiosity as to who this man named Jesus really is. They all knew what happened to the lambs that were brought to the Temple for sacrifice. So this statement of John is a foreshadowing of what will happen to Jesus.

When two of John's disciples heard him say this, they quickly leave him and begin to follow Jesus and Jesus invites them to come and stay with him. Also, in today's Gospel, we hear that one of these two disciples is Andrew, the brother of Simon Peter. Andrew goes and gets his brother and brings him to Jesus. Jesus looks at him and says, "You are Simon the son of John; you will be called Cephas". And as the Gospel tells us, "Cephas", "Kephas" in Aramaic, which means "rock" and is translated as Peter, which also means "rock". Simon's life would never be the same again.

In the first reading, we hear of how Samuel is called by God to be His servant. His life would also be changed forever. Both Simon Peter and Samuel would be faithful servants of God. They would say and do what God asked of them, even though it would bring them much pain and suffering.

All of us are called to be servants of God, disciples of Jesus Christ. We are called to have faith and trust in God. Like Samuel and Simon Peter, we will not be perfect. We will fail at times. But, in faith, we brush things off and continue on our journey as God's disciples, always filled with hope and knowing that God is with us.


