Dear Parishioners,

He is Risen! He is Truly Risen! A joyful Resurrection Day to all of you! Jesus is risen from the dead. In today's Gospel we read about the resurrection as found in the Gospel of John. Mary of Magdala goes to the tomb of Jesus early in the morning and sees that the stone has been removed. She quickly runs to the apostles and tells Peter and John about what she has discovered. Peter and John run to the tomb. John arrives first, since he is younger than Peter and he waits for Peter to arrive and then Peter enters the tomb first and then John follows. He recognizes the authority of Peter as the head of the Apostles. They saw and believed. Jesus gives us the same opportunity to believe and share in His resurrection. When we say we believe, it means that we will do our best to live what we believe, living a life of faithfulness to Jesus and to His Church. Let us do our best to live this life that our Lord has given to us so that we will always share in His Joy and in His Resurrection.

I would like to thank all of you who have made this Holy Week and Easter so special here at Holy Trinity Parish. Thank you to all those who worked so hard to make our celebrations so beautiful --- to Deacon Gene, to those who prepared the Sanctuary each day, to those who served as altar servers, lectors, Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion, ushers, the organist, choir director, the choir, and anyone else who assisted in any way. 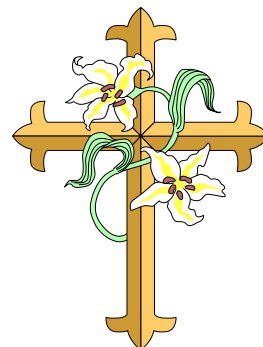
