Dear friends in Christ,

"O most Holy Trinity, Undivided unity, Holy God, mighty God, God immortal be adored!" This is the refrain of one the hymns in honor of the Holy Trinity, God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit. One God, Three Divine Persons. A mystery of our faith. This mystery was revealed to us by Jesus as He said "Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit..." as we heard in today's Gospel according to Matthew. Jesus also spoke of Himself as the Son and how He and the Father are one. He also spoke of sending us the Holy Spirit, which we celebrated last Sunday on the feast of Pentecost. Also, we usually end our prayer by saying "Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit. As it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end. Amen." May the most holy Trinity bless us all.

Next weekend is the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, also known as Corpus Christi. We will have a procession with the Blessed Sacrament after the 5:00 pm Mass on Saturday. Let us join together to honor the Body and Blood of our Lord, present in the Eucharist, the Blessed Sacrament, by participating in this procession. To God be all glory and honor, now and forever.
