This Tuesday, September 15, we will celebrate the feast of Our Lady of Sorrows. We will pray the Rosary at 11:00 am followed by the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick. Everyone is invited to attend.

In today's readings, St. James tells us that faith without works is dead. If we say we have faith, then it must be seen by the works that we do, otherwise our faith is of no use and will not assist us in entering the Kingdom of Heaven. There is no such thing as a "faith alone" salvation. Sacred Scripture makes this very clear. Faith and works must go together if we are to truly be followers of Jesus.

In the Gospel today, St. Peter makes a profession of faith as he tells Jesus, "You are the Christ." Even as he makes this bold profession of faith, his human nature tries to interfere with his faith as he does not want to see Jesus suffer and die. The same is true in today's day and time for us as we struggle with our human nature and many times think only as human beings do and not as God. May our faith sustain us in these struggles against what is true and what is according to the ways of God.
