God slowly revealed His inner life to us. In the Old Testament His unity is stressed; in the New Testament, His three-personhood. He is finally revealed as not only our Lord, but our very Father, "Abba!" One God in three Divine Persons is a truth that requires faith. Many have tried to explain the Trinity: St. Patrick with his shamrock, the scientist with a triangle. In the end, words fail and we accept the truth on the revelation of Jesus Christ.

Jesus reminds His disciples that the Holy Spirit will be sent to guide them "to all truth." Jesus also proclaimed that everything "the Father has is mine." The Father, Son and Holy Spirit will lead us to the truth and guide us in our lives. How do you see the work of the Most Holy Trinity in your own life? In what ways do you need to be open to the Holy Spirit to guide you "to all truth"?

In revealing the **Blessed Trinity** to us, Christ showed us something of God's inner life and His amazing desire to be known by His creatures. But this is not all. Christ said, "If anyone loves Me, he will keep my word, and my Father will love him, and We will come to him and make our abode with him..." And, speaking of the Holy Spirit, Jesus said, "...you shall know Him, because He will dwell with you and be in you." The Blessed Trinity dwells intimately within each of us. This is God's grace-presence. Al long as we have grace, what we really have with us is this presence of God, united to us in the most intimate way possible. This is the indwelling of the Trinity.

This indwelling presence means that even now we are beginning the life of heaven. Anywhere, anytime --- as long as we are not isolated by serious sin --- we can communicate with the Blessed Trinity within us, and be confident of their help. By this indwelling presence, we can come to know and experience the Three Divine Persons. The Father, we realize, is our Father, who loves us and shares His life with us. The Son is our brother, Jesus Christ, who is like us and communicates the Father's love to us and leads us to the Father. The Holy Spirit is most intimately within us, uniting us to Jesus, joining us to the Father --- and to one another --- through, and with, Jesus.
