

#### Dear friends in Christ.

In today's readings, we hear much about love. Jesus tells us that we are to keep His commandment ... and the main commandment is love. What is love? Love is more than a feeling. Love is more than an emotion. Love is a choice we make to give of ourselves unselfishly to and for the good of another, just as Jesus did on the cross. Sometimes I hear people say, "I don't feel like I love that person anymore." Only when we live by feelings and emotions can we make such a statement. True love loves the other person no matter what happens and no matter how they feel. It is a choice we make. True love always tells the truth. True love always is honest. True love says what needs to be said in the spirit of charity even though it may mean that the person that it is said to may not speak to us again. True love does not talk down to other people. True love speaks with humility. True love desires the other person to go to heaven. This means supporting the other person in living a life of faithfulness to Jesus and to His Church. This means not being afraid to tell the other person when they are straying from Jesus and His Church and gently leading them to do what is right, even though doing what is right may be inconvenient or difficult. In order to do this, we must overcome our own feelings and emotions as Jesus did. This can be very difficult when we are insecure or when we are a very "needy" people. But, with the help of the Holy Spirit, we can do it. We just need to have faith and trust in our Lord.

As we honor our Blessed Mother, Mary, during this month of May, don't forget to pray the rosary daily, reflecting upon the mysteries for each day. In doing so, we grow closer to her Son, Jesus, and we grow stronger in our faith.

### **Old Business**

- 1. Parish Mission: will be held October 21-25, 2018.
- 2. Electrical Work: is complete except for some minor items in the PAC.
- 3. Parking Lot Repairs: we are getting bids to fix the all areas of the parking lot that need repair including the area around the dumpster at the PAC Bldg.
- 4. A/C & Heating in the Church and RE/Office Building: the work is complete.

### **New Business**

- 1. Corpus Christi Procession: will take place on Saturday, June 2, after the 5 p.m. Mass. Setup will be done that Saturday morning.
- 2. June Fundraiser: will be held on Sunday, June 3.
- 3. Bazaar: will be held on Sunday, September 16. We will have the first formal meeting in June.
- 4. Diocesan Capital Campaign: will begin in July 2018. Further information will be published in the bulletin soon.

### Ministry/Committee Reports

- 1. Social Ministry: the Locker Project was very successful. On Sunday, April 29, we will have our 5th Sunday second collection, with 50% of the proceeds going to the Jarrell Food Pantry and 50% going to our parish's Social Ministry fund.
- 2. Faith Formation Program: preparations are being made for First Holy Communion on May 5 for four of our CCE children. The May Crowning will be held on May 16, which is the last class day for this school year, and Vacation Bible School will be held on June 9.
- 3. Cemetery: dirt work is complete. Plans are being made to use a spray machine for weed control. We will be adding about 300 feet of fence, for which bids are being obtained.
- 4. Finance Council: no report was available as the Council is meeting after the Pastoral Council.

- 2. Thanks were offered to the Pastoral Council for preparing the meal for Confirmation, which was held on March 11.
