This weekend, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord. We read, in the Acts of the Apostles 1:1-11, of how Jesus appeared to the Apostles for a period of forty days. Forty is a number often used in the Bible to express a time a preparation and completion. So, when the Apostles were fully prepared to continue the ministry of Jesus, He was ascended to Heaven and then, ten days later, sent the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles, and the others who were gathered with them, in the upper room. The account of the Ascension is also found in the Gospel of Mark as we heard in today's readings. The Ascension is also mentioned in the Gospel of Luke. Jesus ascended into Heaven so that the Holy Spirit, also called the Advocate and Paraclete, would be sent to guide and lead the Apostles in spreading the Good News and in forming the Church.

As we prepare to celebrate Pentecost next Sunday, I would encourage you to say this **'Prayer to the Holy Spirit'** each day this week.

*Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of Thy faithful
and enkindle in them the fire of Thy love.
Send forth Thy Spirit and they shall be created.
And Thou shalt renew the face of the earth.
O God, Who by the light of the Holy Spirit,
didst instruct the hearts of the faithful,
grant us in the same Spirit to be truly wise
and ever to rejoice in His consolation.
Through Christ our Lord. Amen*

The liturgical color for Pentecost Sunday is red. I encourage you to wear something red next weekend to Mass as a reminder to all that we are celebrating the great Feast of Pentecost.
