Dear friends in Christ,

Merry Christmas and Happy New Year! Thank you to all who came to the black-eye pea and cornbread reception after the Mass on New Year's night. Thank you especially to those who made the black-eye peas and cornbread and to those who made all the preparations. May the Lord bless you for your kindness to all of us.

Today we celebrate the great feast of Epiphany when Jesus was revealed to the world by the coming of the three Wise Men or Magi or Kings. Three important men come to see the boy who would become the King of the Universe, the King of Kings and the Lord of Lords. Just as Jesus was seen by the three Wise Men, He is still seen today by those who partake of Him in the Eucharist, as we gaze upon His Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity. Only those who have faith are able to recognize this special Real Presence of Jesus in our midst. May our faith remain strong so that we will always be drawn to His presence in the Eucharist and so that we will always have the desire to receive His Body and Blood in Holy Communion. The Eucharist is the Star of Jesus that shines brightly at each Mass or when we come to adore Him in Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. May we always be drawn to this Star so that all darkness of evil will be removed from our life and then, we also, become the Star of Jesus to others. Keep that Star shining brightly by making a good and frequent confession in the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

Here is a short reflection for the feast of Epiphany:

O slavnosti Zjevení Páně ("Tří králů") hledíme na zkušenost mudrců, kteří následováním hvězdy nalézají Světlo. Hvězda, která se jim ukázala na nebi, zažehla v jejich mysli a srdci světlo, které je podněcuje, aby hledali velké Světlo Kristovo. Mudrcové věrně následují světlo, které prostupuje jejich nitro, a setkávají se s Pánem.

Cesta mudrců z Východu symbolizuje úděl každého člověka. Náš život je poutí. Cestou jsme osvěcováni světly, abychom nalezli plnost pravdy a lásky, kterou my křesťané rozpoznáváme v Ježíši, Světlu světa. Důležité je bdít a naslouchat Bohu, který k nám neustále mluví. Jak praví Žalm: "Svítilnou mým nohám je tvé slovo a světlem mé stezce" (Žl 119,105). Zvláště naslouchání evangeliu, jeho četba, rozjímání o evangeliu, které se tak stává naším duchovním pokrmem, nám umožňuje setkat se s živým Ježíšem a učinit zkušenost s Ním a Jeho láskou.

Na slavnost Zjevení Páně si připomínáme, jak se Ježíš ukázal lidstvu v tváři Dítěte a vedle sebe vnímáme mudrce jakožto prozíravé průvodce na cestě. Jejich příklad nám pomáhá pozvedat zraky ke hvězdě a sledovat velké touhy svého srdce. Učí nás nespokojovat se s průměrností života "malé kocábky", nýbrž nechávat se vždy podmaňovat dobrem, pravdou a krásou - Bohem, který je tím vším a vždy více!

Příklad mudrců nás také učí nenechat se klamat zdáním, tím, co je pro tento svět velké, moudré a mocné. Netřeba se u toho zastavovat. Je zapotřebí střežit víru. V této době je důležité chránit víru. Je třeba jít dál, překročit tmu, vábení Sirén, překročit zesvětštění a jeho četné dnešní formy a jít do Betléma, tam, kde v jednoduchosti domu na periferii, mezi maminkou a tatínkem oplývajícími láskou a vírou září Slunce, které vzešlo z výsosti, Král veškerenstva. It is the tradition that on the Feast of the Epiphany that we bless our homes by marking them with blessed chalk with the current year and the initials of the Three Wise Men - Caspar, Melchior and Balthasar.
