Here we are at the Second Sunday of Advent. Advent is a time of preparation for the celebration of the Birth of Jesus and also for the Second Coming of Jesus. "Repent, for the Kingdom of Heaven is at hand!" These are the words of St. John in today's Gospel. He is the one sent to prepare the way of the Lord. His message was one of advice of what we need to do to prepare ourselves to meet our Lord. Have we followed his advice? In this bulletin you will find the list of Penance Services for our Deanery. Please take the advice of St. John and make a good confession before we celebrate Christmas.

The first reading at Mass during these weeks is taken from the Book of the Prophet Isaiah. In his book he describes the coming of the Messiah, what the Messiah will be like, what the Messiah will do. Reflect upon his words and upon Jesus and allow them to speak to your heart so that the Messiah, Jesus, will transform you into His image and likeness

This Monday, December 9, we celebrate a Holy Day as we honor the Blessed Virgin Mary and her Immaculate Conception in the womb of her mother St. Anne. All Catholics should attend Mass on this Holy Day. Let us gather together to reflect upon how Mary was prepared from the time of her conception in the womb of her mother to be the mother of the Savior. Mary, under the title of the Immaculate Conception, is the patroness of the United States. Our Masses will be on Monday, December 9, at 12:00 noon and at 7:00 pm.

Thursday, December 12, is the **Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe**. Let us come together to honor our Lady through whose intercession over 9 million people learned about Jesus, her Son, and were converted to the faith in what is today Mexico. Mass will be at the usual time of 7:00 am.


K úvaze: Sekera je přiložena ke stromu? mohou tato slova vzbudit radostné očekávání ?přicházejícího?? Nevyvolají spíš odpor, strach, útěk? Jan Křtitel se těmito slovy snažil vyburcovat lid k obrácení, k přípravě cesty pro Mesiáše. Ačkoli to byl prorok, ba dokonce víc než prorok, jeho slova byla také odrazem tehdejších představ: Pán přijde a hned se vypořádá se vším, nastolí okamžitý pořádek, vymýtí zlé, přinese slávu Izraeli. Jan Křtitel, ačkoli byl největší mezi narozenými ze ženy, neměl ?plný vhled? do Božích plánů spásy, které se ukázaly teprve Ježíšovým příchodem. Kristus nakonec ukázal evangelium v jiném světle, a tak zároveň poopravil jeho ?zkreslené? představy. On totiž svým příchodem přinesl veškerou novost, novost tak radikální, že ani Jan Křtitel, největší prorok, nemohl mít odpovídající představu: mohl o ní mít jen matné tušení, promíchané navíc s falešnými představami. A nad tím bychom uvažovat i dále: mnohá slova proroků o mesiánské době jsou jen stínem skutečnosti, kterou přinesl Kristus. On je převyšuje, i když se nám to ještě ?nejeví?, protože dosud čekáme na jasné vyzáření jeho slávy. Jeho dary převyšují ?přislíbená mesiánská dobra?, i když se nám někdy zdá pravý opak. Ale jeho cesty jsou jiné než naše, jsou to cesty božské.

Přece jen Jan Křtitel měl pravdu: Kristus odděluje zrno od plev, očišťuje ohněm, přináší ?slávu?, avšak jiným způsobem, než si on představoval. Kristus sice očišťuje ohněm, ale nespaluje hříšníky, ale hřích. Slovem a činem očišťuje od hříchu a ode všech jeho důsledků: od nemoci, od spoutanosti, od smrti. A opět: ne hned, jak si představoval ?předchůdce Páně?, ale postupně. A v tom bychom i my mohli pocítit určitou obtíž: rádi bychom ?měli hned?, podle svých představ. Ale Kristus jedná jinak: nevyplnil představy Křtitele, nevyplní ani naše. Ale zato se můžeme spolehnout, že vyplní ?naše představy? mnohem skvělejším způsobem, než bychom očekávali. Skvělejším způsobem, ba dokonce božským. Na naší představě o Kristu závisí i naše očekávání, naše ?obrácení?, naše motivace: strach či radosť? Uzavřenost či otevřenosť? Spěchání vstříc nebo útěk?
