Dear Parishioners,

He is Risen! He is Truly Risen! Today, in a very special way, we celebrate the Resurrection of the Lord. As we celebrate this day, we must always remember that, in order for Jesus to rise from the dead, He first had to endure terrible torture and pain. He first had to carry the cross, be nailed to it, and then die upon it. This is what we have celebrated in this Sacred Paschal Triduum, from Holy Thursday through Easter Sunday. In reality, this is what we remember and celebrate every time we celebrate the Mass. The event of our redemption and salvation is continued through the celebration of the Mass every day of the year. That is why the Mass has redemptive value for those who have died and that is why we celebrate Mass for the repose of their soul. Today let us glory in the Resurrection and live our lives in a way that shows that we truly believe that Jesus rose from the dead to give each of us new life.


Myšlenky k promluvě: Vstoupit do hrobu, vytesaného ve skále, není právě povzbuzující skutečností. Podívat se smrti do tváře nebývá chápáno jako zdroj naděje. A přece bez pravdivého pohledu na tuto skutečnost nelze pochopit dobře ani vzkříšení, nelze žít z naděje, kterou vzkříšení v sobě nese. Petr a Jan byli Ježíšovi velmi blízko, a přece jim byla po ukřižování asi bližší jistota smrti, než živá naděje ve vzkříšení. Evangelium se ale nad tím nijak nepohoršuje, nepovažuje to za příliš překvapivé. Nejsme na tom vlastně jinak. I pro nás je jistota zla, smrti, špatných konců mnoha věci, opřená o zkušenost, trpkou ale mocnou životní jistotou. Lidé na ni reagují různě: od cynismu přes nerealistické spoléhání na sebe samé až po lehkovážné přijetí nejrůznějších podivných pomocí, které čím jsou zamlženější, tím větší důvěry požívají. Víra ve vzkříšení si i u nás jen těžko a váhavě razí cestu výše zmíněnou houštinou obranných reakcí. Znovu a znovu jsme zraňováni svou bezmocí vůči moci zla a smrti. A znovu a znovu jsme vyzýváni, abychom vpustili Boha do svého života. Abychom využili možnosti křesťanů žít z Ducha svatého. Abychom tedy zakusili nekonečnou moc života Božího ve vlastním zranitelném a mnohokrát zraněném životě.

Pro víru ve vzkříšení potřebuje svědectví Písem, svědectví těch, kteří se s Ježíšem tehdy v Palestině setkali a svědectví těch, kdo v uplynulých staletích ze skutečnosti vzkříšení žili - svědectví světců. Ale potřebujeme také vlastní zkušenost moci a síly Kristovy v našem popleteném a v mnohém pokaženém životě. Potřebujeme nahlédnout do svých vlastních životních hrobů a objevit, že Pán přesto žije a je zdrojem života i pro nás. (Pastorace.cz)
