

Born January 28, 1225, he was an Italian Dominican friar, philosopher, Catholic priest and Doctor of the Church. An immensely influential philosopher, theologian, and jurist in the tradition of scholasticism, he is also known withinthe latter as the Doctor Angelicus and the Doctor Communis.

Bishop Joe Vásquez, in communion with Pope Francis, invites all the faithful to have their voices heard, leading up to the XVI Ordinary General Assembly of the Synod of Bishops, by completing the survey linked at www.austindiocese.org/synod-for-a-synodal-church. The survey will be available until Jan. 31, 2022. The questions center around the theme "For a Synodal Church: Communion, Participation and Mission." During this time parishes will also hold listening sessions. Once concluded, all responses will be compiled into a report and submitted to the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB). The USCCB will then submit a national report for the General Assembly of the Synod of Bishops in Rome. Please know, the information raised during the consultation phase in our diocese will be reviewed and used for our own pastoral planning.

K úvaze: Dnešní evangelium je sesazeno ze dvou úryvků, v evangeliu poměrně odlehlých. Je to jednak slavnostní úvod k Lukášově dílu, vlastně věnování díla nám blíže neurčenému "vznešenému Teofilovi" a dále určité předznamenání nebo spíš zkratka významu celé Ježíšovy činnosti, scéna ze synagogy v Kafarnaum.

Prvá část říká, že evangelium je uspořádáním a zapsáním toho, co bylo vyprávěno a předáváno (tradice, ústně předávaná, je prvotní!), a je určeno těm, kdo víru přijali skrze vyučování a skrze ústní hlásání.

Druhá část charakterizuje Ježíšovu činnost jako naplnění proroctví o velkém Božím osvobození. Víra, která stojí skutečně na slovu Božím , čerpá z příběhů Písma neobyčejnou jistotu o Boží snaze osvobodit člověka, která v Kristu vrcholí a naplňuje se. (Pastorace.cz)
