Dear Parishioners,

He is Risen! He is Truly Risen! Today, in a very special way, we celebrate the Resurrection of the Lord. As we celebrate this day we must always remember that in order for Jesus to rise from the dead He first had to endure terrible torture and pain. He first had to carry the cross, be nailed to it, and then die upon it. This is what we have celebrated in this Sacred Paschal Triduum, from Holy Thursday through Easter Sunday. In reality, this is what we remember and celebrate every time we celebrate the Mass. The event of our redemption and salvation is continued through the celebration of the Mass every day of the year. That is why the Mass has redemptive value for those who have died, and that is why we celebrate Mass for the repose of their soul. Today let us glory in the Resurrection and live our lives in a way that shows that we truly believe that Jesus rose from the dead to give each of us new life.

I would like to thank all of you who have made this Holy Week and Easter so special here at Holy Trinity. Thank you to all those who worked so hard to make our celebrations so beautiful. Thank you to Deacon Gene, to those who prepared the Sanctuary each day, who served as altar servers, lectors, Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion, ushers, the organist, choir director and the choir, and to anyone else who assisted in any way. I know that many of you spent a lot of hours preparing for these celebrations. Thank you for your commitment to our Lord and to His Church.

Next Sunday is Divine Mercy Sunday. We will have a special Divine Mercy Service consisting of the Blessing of the Image of Divine Mercy, Adoration, Chaplet of Divine Mercy, and the Litany of Divine Mercy at 3:00 p.m. Everyone is invited to attend.
