He is Risen! He is Truly Risen! This is the cry of the apostles as they realize that Jesus has risen from the dead. Once they saw the empty tomb and then experienced Jesus appearing to them in the upper room they finally came to understand what Jesus meant when He said that he must suffer and die and then raise up on the third day. What joy must have filled their hearts at seeing Jesus for the first time after the resurrection. 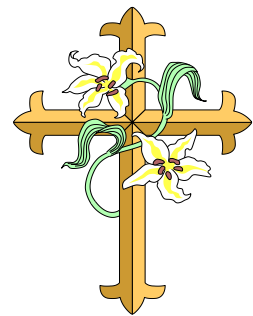


The Resurrection of Jesus Christ
