Dear friends in Christ.

Praised be the Risen Lord! Alleluia! Today we congratulate those who will be receiving their First Holy Communion this weekend. As they receive the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of our Lord may they know who it is they are receiving and may they always have a desire in their heart to receive Him often.

Here we are already at the Third Sunday of Easter. As we continue to celebrate the Resurrection of the Lord, we are reading gospel passages which contain the events of Jesus appearing to His disciples after the resurrection. In today's Gospel Jesus appears to the Apostles at the Sea of Tiberias. Peter and the others have gone fishing and once again have caught nothing. Jesus once again instructs them where to fish and they catch a net full of fish. They realize it is Jesus and quickly go to shore. Jesus tells them to bring some of the fish and then He prepares breakfast for them. After this Jesus looks at Peter and says, "Simon, son of John, do you love me more than these?" Jesus asks this to Peter three times, the number of times Peter denied knowing Jesus after Jesus' arrest. Peter replies, "Yes, Lord, you know that I love you." Jesus tells Peter to feed His lambs, tend His sheep, and feed His sheep. Jesus is reaffirming Peter's position as leader of the Apostles and as the leader of this Church that the Apostles will form. Jesus also lets Peter know that he will have to suffer just as Jesus suffered. We are all called to express our love to Jesus by being willing to suffer for Him and His Church. In the midst of persecution we are asked to be strong, to have faith, and to trust in the Lord. We are called to proclaim the Truth and defend the Church against lies and false accusations. To do this we must be knowledgeable of our faith. This is one reason why our parish is providing all of you with the FORMED website. It has a wealth of resource materials, such as saints' videos, history of the Church videos, Sacrament videos, Bible Study and much more. We must study and learn and rely on the Holy Spirit to give us what we need so that we can speak as Jesus would have us to speak. We must know what the Truth is so that we can defend this Church that Jesus established. We must be able to root out lies that are continually present in the media, whether it be on TV, radio, newspapers or the internet. We must speak the Truth! Pope Francis also has continued to emphasize how we must learn to help those in need by educating them and helping them with their needs, especially in being merciful, compassionate and understanding to them in their situation in life. In doing so we give faithful witness to Jesus Christ. Please take advantage of this great resource and grow in knowledge of your faith while growing closer to God and His Church. As we hear in today's second reading from the Book of Revelation, "To the one who sits on the throne and to the Lamb be blessing and honor, glory and might, forever and ever." "Amen."

Don't forget that Mother's Day is next Sunday. Love them while you still have them with you in this world.

Myšlenky: Kde hledat vzkříšeného Ježíše? Jak poznat, co ode mne chce? Jak to udělat, aby mne neminul ...? To jsou ušlechtilé otázky, ale možná, že také zbytečné. Podíváme-li se do evangelií, vidíme situaci spíš opačnou: Ježíš přichází za svými učedníky. A to před svým vzkříšením, i po něm. Ježíš je tím, kdo začíná hovor. Ježíš je ten, kdo dává radu. A Ježíše poslouchají někdy ti, kdo mu uvěří a kdo ho berou vážně a jindy ti, kteří si myslí, že znají věci lépe něž on, že by je spíš měl poslechnout on sám.

Pro mne samotného z toho vyplývá zcela praktická otázka: kde stojím já? Jsem tím, kdo poslouchá, kdo vnímá, kdo uskutečňuje Ježíšovo slovo? Jsem tím, kdo ví, že Ježíš ví, co je potřeba? Jsem tím, kdo věří, že Ježíš poradí lépe i tam, kde já jsem přesvědčen, že věci dobře znám? Vždyť při rybolovu, o kterém jsme slyšeli v evangeliu, radil zkušeným profesionálům - rybářům! A radil jim něco, co žádný rybář nemohl udělat, totiž spustit sítě ve dne a ne v noci. A přece stálo za to ho poslechnout!

Nechme se tím povzbudit. Začněme si dělat starosti o to, jestli Ježíšovo slovo vnímáme. Televize ani noviny nám toto slovo většinou sdělovat nebudou. Ale slovo Písma a učení církve nám ho sdělují stále! Jde o to, chovat se opravdu jako učedník: tedy naslouchat a učit se. Naslouchat, učit se a dělat to, co náš Mistr a Pán říká. Nevystačit si s vlastními zkušenostmi. Neprosazovat si jen svou. Ale v prvé řadě setkávat se s Ježíšovým slovem a slyšet ho. Poslouchat ho pozorněji a s větším zájmem než jakékoliv zprávy, než jakékoliv senzace, než cokoliv jiného. Vždyť kdo jiný nám ukazuje cestu ke skutečné pravdě, ke skutečnému dobru, k cíli v nebi? Kdo jiný, než Ježíš, ukřižovaný a vzkříšený, živý, ten, který mluví ve své církvi?

Ve chvíli, kdy Ježíše mnozí opouštěli, říká Petr: "Pane, ke komu půjdeme? Ty máš slova věčného života". To neplatilo jen tehdy, to platí i dnes. A bude to platit až do konce světa. Takže - věnuji Ježíšovu slovu pozornost? Je to pro mne slovo první, slovo nejdůležitější? Nic jiného si toto slovo nezaslouží. (Pastorace.cz)
