

Dear friends in Christ.

Peace be with you. A very happy Mother's Day to all of our mothers. I hope and pray that you have a very blessed and joyful Mothers' Day.

Here we are in this beautiful month of May. May is always a month dedicated to the Blessed Virgin Mary. Friday, May 13, is the memorial of Our Lady of Fatima. Have you ever read about the apparition of Mary in Fatima, Portugal in 1917? It is quite remarkable and the final apparition, which included the miracle of the sun, was witnessed by thousands of people and reported in newspapers throughout the world. I would recommend you taking time to read about this apparition and/or watch the movie about it, paying special attention to Mary's message to the three children that she appeared to.

On Friday, May 13, the feast day of Our Lady of Fatima, we will have Mass at 7:00 am and at 11:00 am. At the 11:00 am Mass the Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick will be available to those who wish to receive it.

As I mentioned a few weeks ago, the weather has been much warmer lately. Usually when summer approaches we are tempted to dress rather lightly or skimpy for Mass. We need to remember that as we come to Mass we come to worship God and to receive His Son in Holy Communion. We should dress in a way that shows respect for God. The general rule that I believe is appropriate is that anyone over 6 years of age should not wear shorts to Mass. Also, girls and ladies should wear blouses or dresses that are appropriate for Mass, nothing strapless or no spaghetti straps. Some say that God doesn't care what you wear to Mass. Well, that may be so. But the question should be "do you love God enough that you care what you wear to Mass?" Do you stand in honor in His presence? Also, if you dress appropriately for Mass you will not be cold in church from the air conditioning. If the air is blowing on you and you are cold, try to move to another part of the church.

Today's Gospel is very short but contains a powerful message. Jesus says, "My sheep hear my voice; I know them, and they follow me." Jesus is the Shepherd, we are His sheep. Do we listen to the voice of Jesus and follow Him, or, are we listening to too many other voices that tell us to live in a way that is contrary to the way of Jesus? Too many Christians today are following a voice other than the voice of Jesus. They have accepted teachings that are not those of Jesus. But yet they seem to convince themselves that those teachings are ok. Teachings such as abortion, contraception, tubal ligations, vasectomies, divorce, euthanasia, living together before marriage (cohabitation), pornography, illegal drug use, excessive use of alcohol, cursing, gossip, slander, and many other sins. Those who say that these are ok to do are not speaking in the name of Jesus. Let us only listen to the voice of Jesus. As He says in today's Gospel, "I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish." Living the way of Jesus as the Church teaches leads us to Heaven. Don't allow other voices to lead you in the opposite direction.

This being the month of Mary, we will have the Crowning of the Blessed Virgin Mary on Wednesday, May 11. It will also be the closing Mass for our Religious Education Year. Come and honor the mother of Jesus, who is also our Mother.

Myšlenky: Touha po jistotě je zřejmě jedna z nejsilnějších tužeb v člověku. A lidé velmi těžko nesou, když o sebechabější jistoty přijdou. Jak jsme na tom my, křesťané? Jaké jsou naše jistoty? Na čem stavíme a na co spoléháme? Kde se cítíme úplně v bezpečí? Je to u Boha? Nespěchejme s odpovědí. Řada hodných věřících lidí se domnívá, že si počínají velmi zbožně když říkají:" já bych rád do nebe, já sice vím, že mne má Bůh rád, ale kdoví, jak dopadnu. Copak já si to nebe zasloužím? Vím snad, jak se na mne bude při posledním soudu Pán Bůh dívat?" A tak podobně. Jistě, nejsme ještě u cíle své cesty, a tak právem uvažujeme o tom, že jsme schopni svou cestu k Bohu pokazit, že jsme schopni se vydat jednoho dne špatnou cestou ... Ano, jistotu v sobě samotných nemáme a mít nemůžeme. Bylo by pošetilé říkat, že já se nemohu zmýlit a že já se sám v sobě nemohu zklamat. Ovšem jak je to s jistotou, kterou nemám v sobě samém, ale v Bohu? Je totiž známou věcí, že nemá-li člověk hlubokou jistotu v Bohu, začne si hledat nakonec velmi mělké jistoty v tomto světě. A tím si nijak nepomůže, spíš naopak.

O čem nás to ale dnes ujišťovalo Písmo? O tom, že Ježíši nikdo jeho ovce z jeho ruky nevyrve. Že on sám jim dává věčný život. Že z Otcovy ruky nikdo Ježíšovy ovce nevezme. Takže zbývá jedna jediná otázka: patřím já mezi Ježíšovy ovce? Patřím do jeho stáda církve? Patřím Ježíši? Vím, že si mne zamiloval, že mi odpustil, že on sám mne bere do své ruky? Vím, že mne drží a nechce mne pustit, když by si zlo na mne dělalo nárok? Vím, že z Ježíšovy ruky mohu tedy utéci jen já sám? Mám tuto jistotu? Velmi na ní záleží. Protože bez ní se budu podobat člověku, který vidí krásnou pevninu, chce na ni z moře doplavat, ale stále má obavu, že cestu nevydrží, že nedoplave, a tak samým strachem začne polykat jeden doušek za druhým a může utonout.

Zopakujme to tedy ještě jednou: my sami nejsme žádnou jistotou. Věřit neoblomně jen sobě samotnému je prostě pošetilost. Ježíš je naší jistotou. To on nás má ve své ruce. Nese nás. Sám nás nechce ztratit. A je se svým Otcem zajedno, on a Otec jednou jsou. Kam by tedy člověk šel? Kde najde víc? A pokud toto přijal, čeho by se bál? Vždyť ten, který nás drží a nese, zná naše slabosti a naše nebezpečí stokrát lépe než my. A je láska. A je pravda. A chce nás víc, než my jeho! Je tedy důvod ke strachu? A má smysl hledat jistoty jinde než u něho?
