He is Risen! He is Truly Risen! This past Wednesday we celebrated the closing Mass for our Religious Education school year that included the Crowning of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Thank you to Lucille D'Elia and all the catechists and helpers who teach and love each of the students. They always strive for the students to learn about the love of Jesus and the Way He wants them to live as His disciples. These weeks after Easter Sunday we have been reading from the Gospel of John passages that spoke of the events immediately following the resurrection of Jesus. Last Sunday we heard from the 10th chapter of John that spoke of Jesus as the Shepherd. This week we are thrust back to the events of Holy Thursday in which Jesus speaks about how now is the time for Him to be glorified. We are reminded of the fact that this glorification came about through His suffering, death and resurrection. We are reminded that we experience the joy of the resurrection because of the His suffering and death. During the month of May we give honor to our Blessed Mother, Mary. Don't forget to pray the rosary daily reflecting upon the mysteries for each day. In doing so we grow closer to her Son, Jesus, and we grow stronger in our faith.

This Monday and Tuesday is the Diocesan Council of Catholic Women's convention in Round Rock. Please pray for all these women who do so much for the Church, especially for assisting in the education of men for the priesthood through their CEF card sales. May God's blessings be upon them all.

K úvaze: Není nic snazšího (a neúčinnějšího), než mluvit a mluvit o tom, jak se máme milovat. Ježíš sám nejprve přiváděl lidi k zážitku lásky Boží ("synu, odpouštějí se ti hříchy!", "Zachee, pojď rychle dolů"... atd), sám dal svůj život v sázku, než aby jen mluvil o tom, že je třeba se navzájem milovat. Ostatně nelze zapomenout na to, že schopnost mít lásku k druhým je podmíněna určitým osobnostním vyzráním člověka, není to jen něco, co podle opakovaných výzev mohou lidé nacvičit. A toto vyzrání také roste z osobního poznávání Boží lásky k nám. Láska podle evangelia není nevědomá a slepá. Souvisí jistě i s poznáním. Nicméně láska v Ježíšově stylu nestojí na deklarované pravdě, ale na pravdivém postoji: Ježíš je rozhodnut stát a být zde pro své bližní a to i za cenu smrti. A je rozhodnut milovat i tenkrát, když jeho láska není ani chápána ani opětována. Plná láska vyžaduje plné odhodlání k chudobě - a snášení chudoby. A to nejen materiální. Jinak se může stát frází, zástěrkou nebo dobře maskovaným násilím a manipulací s člověkem.
