Today's Gospel is focused upon peace and love. "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you." Jn 14:27a. These are the words of Jesus in today's Gospel. Jesus said that the peace He gives is not the peace the world offers to us. But, it is a peace that is internal, within us, that is always existent even when the peace of the world is crumbling around us, as it does not only in times of war, but also when we experience turmoil, crisis, tragedy, death, violence, and election year. Even in these times the peace of Jesus is with us if we are focused on Him and if we are keeping His word.

In today's Gospel Jesus says, "Whoever loves me will keep my word, and my Father will love him, and we will come to him and make our dwelling with him." Keeping God's Word is vital in living in union with God and with His Church. In today's first reading we hear how some were not living and teaching God's Word, but only their own word that they wanted to teach. We hear of how the apostles had to send out a letter to correct what these false teachers had said. The Church still does this often in today's world as many people teach not the truth that has been handed on for the last two thousand years, but their own teaching. Before we accept the word from so-called preachers and teachers we need to look at what has been consistently taught from the time of the apostles and not just something that came about from the 15th and 16th centuries that was no longer consistent with previous teachings. May we keep God's Word and live it each day and in doing so will God truly dwell in us.

May the blessings of our Lord be with each of you.

K úvaze: Vzývat Ducha svatého jen v nouzi, když něco nevím u zkoušky? To by bylo opravdu málo... Vzývat Ducha před četbou Božího slova? To je už přiměřenější aplikace evangelního textu. A že toto je pro náš život méně důležité než to první? Na první pohled ano – to první je takové „praktičtější“, konkrétnější. Ale pochopit Ježíšovo slovo? Jaký to má význam pro můj život? A navíc: toto „pochopení“ může být nebezpečné, protože mě může posléze vyzvat k určitým životním změnám... možná nepříjemným. Takže je lepší zůstat v blahé nevědomosti, ne?

Tato nevědomost je „sladká“ pro toho, kdo nepoznal Krista, nepoznal moc jeho slova. Ale pokud můžeme s Petrem opakovat: „Pane, ke komu bychom šli, vždyť ty máš slova věčného života“ (Jan 6,68), pak „automaticky“ můžeme dodat: „Ke komu bychom šli? Ty máš Ducha života, Ducha pravdy“. Ano, protože Duch pravdy nás učí, jak správně chápat Ježíšovo slovo: on totiž zná hlubiny Boží, proto „může do těchto hlubin uvést“. Chceš „proniknout do Božích hlubin“? Chceš poznat Boha ještě víc? (Nejen rozumem a teoreticky, ale celou osobou). Pak vzývej Ducha! Anebo... cítíš, že Ježíšovo slovo k tobě vůbec nepromlouvá, nechává tě chladným? Pak potřebuješ Ducha, vždyť „jen přirozený člověk nemůže přijmout věci Božího Ducha: jsou mu bláznovstvím a nemůže je chápat, protože se dají posoudit jen Duchem“ (1 Kor 2,14). Ano, kdykoli vnímáš, že tě evangelium neoslovuje, pak pros Ducha, aby ti otevřel srdce, aby ti dal porozumění Božím slovům. (Pastorace.cz)
